INFORMATION WE COLLECT AND HOW WE USE IT:

Legal Document Help Center collects certain information from and about its users in three ways: directly from web server logs, the user’s input and with cookies.

Web Server Logs

When you visit our website, we may track information to administer the site and analyze its usage.

Examples of information we may track include:

- Your internet protocol address
- The browser and type of computer you use
- Number of links you click within the site
- State or country from which you accessed the site
- Date and time of your visit
- Name of your internet service provider
- Web page/link you arrived from
- Pages you viewed on the site

Use of Cookies

Legal Document Help Center may use cookies to personalize or enhance your user experience. A cookie is a small text file that is placed on your hard disk by a web page server.
